TO ESTABLISH A SIGNALIZED SCHOOL CROSSWALK
LOCATED ON EAST 124TH STREET SOUTH, JASPER COUNTY, IOWA**

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors deems it necessary for the purpose of promoting the health, safety and general welfare of Jasper County, Iowa and its citizens to enact such an ordinance, and,

Whereas, the Board of Supervisors has met all statutory requirements relating to the subject matter of this Ordinance;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE
BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF JASPER COUNTY, IOWA:**

Authority

The Authority for this Ordinance is Iowa Code Section 331.302, County Legislation.

Purpose

The purpose of this ordinance is to establish a signalized school crosswalk on East 124th Street South located 635 feet north of the intersection of East 124th Street South and Highway F-62 East.

Ordinance

A signalized crosswalk is hereby established on East 124th Street South, located 635 feet north of the intersection of East 124th Street South and Highway F-62 East, in Jasper County, Iowa.

Enforcement


Iowa Code Sections 321.257, and 321.325 through 321.330 are hereby adopted and incorporated by reference as if fully set forth herein. Violations of this Ordinance for signalized crosswalk shall be enforced as violations of the referenced sections of the Iowa Code.

Effective Date

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, adoption and publication, as provided by Iowa law.


