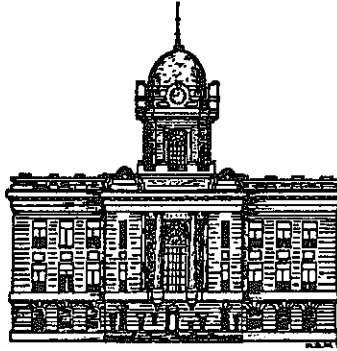

WHY SHOULD JASPER COUNTY SUPPORT RRACAP?

Space Costs for the RRACAP/Jasper County Center are a major priority for the delivery of services in Jasper County.

Services provided by the staff are listed on the attached program sheet and include Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program, Homeless Assistance and Emergency Utility Assistance. Staff also works to help clients apply for Rent Rebate, Hawki Insurance, Food Stamps and reduced-priced garbage collection. Our staff works to help clients attain and maintain some level of self-sufficiency.

RRACAP/Jasper County employs one full-time county coordinator and one part-time clerical outreach worker.

We are very grateful for the space provided by the county. The office was remodeled to accommodate us and the space costs have been granted to us.

Our presence in Jasper County is vital to the low-income population. Our staff is dedicated to assuring that no one who needs fuel or shelter should have to do without.
