RESOLUTION #______A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF APPLICATION FOR ANNEXATION PROPOSED TO THE CITY OF PRAIRIE CITY, IOWA

WHEREAS, the Jasper County Board of Supervisors has met in consultation on February 11, 2014, with the township trustees of those townships that contain the portion of the territory proposed to be annexed, and

WHEREAS, the City provided written notice to the Board of Supervisors and the Supervisors held this consultation regarding a proposed annexation of certain property in Jasper County, Iowa, legally described as:

Parcel E in the East Half of the Southeast Quarter of Section 36, Township 79 North, Range 21 West of the 5th P.M., Jasper County, Iowa, as appears in plat recorded in Book 1154, page 464 in the office of the Recorder of said County.

AND

The East 6 acres of the South Quarter of the Northeast Quarter Southeast Quarter Section 36, Township 79 North Range 21 West of the 5th P.M., Jasper County, Iowa.

AND

Part of Government Lot 4 in Section 2, Township 78 North, Range 21 West of the 5th P.M., Jasper County, Iowa, which lies South of Highway No. 163 as shown in Condemnation recorded in Book 953, page 133 in the office of the Recorder of said County and which lies North of Highway No. 163 as shown in Condemnation recorded in Book 1074, page 589 in the office of the Recorder of said County, EXCEPT that part of said Government Lot 4 which lies in a triangular tract of land described as bounded on the North by the Southerly right-of-way line of the C.R.I.&P. Railroad, bounded on the East by a line 200 feet normally distant Westerly from and parallel to the East line of Lot 5 of Government Lot 3 in said Section 2, as appears in plat recorded in Plat book B, page 437 in the office of the Recorder of said County, bounded on the South by a line 60 feet normally distant Northerly of and parallel to the centerline of existing Primary Road designated Iowa No. 163. AND A triangular tract of land being all that part of Government Lot 4 of Section 2, Township 78 North, Range 21 West of the 5th P.M., Jasper County, Iowa and all that part of Lot 5 of Government Lot 3 of said Section 2 as appears in Plat recorded in Plat Book B, page 437 in the office of the Recorder of said County, described as bounded on the North by the Southerly right-of-way line of the C.R.I.&P. Railroad, bounded on the East by a line 200 feet normally distant Westerly from and parallel to the East line of said Lot 5 of Government Lot 3, bounded on the South by a line 60 feet normally distant Northerly of and parallel to the centerline of existing Primary Road designated Iowa No. 163.

WHEREAS, the annexation application was voluntary and appears to serve the public purpose in that a portion of the real estate involved is dedicated to City cemetery with another portion involved currently owned by the City of Prairie City and with another portion involved currently owned by Prairie City Economic Development Corporation and JEDCO. Said real estate is in a location that makes it attractive to development.

This resolution supersedes Resolution 14-08 correcting the legal description that was previously presented.

NOW THEREFORE, the Jasper County Board of Supervisors does hereby take the position in support of said application as a result of said consultation.
