Tuesday, June 23, 2015 the Jasper County Board of Supervisors met in regular session at 9:30 a.m. with Supervisors Carpenter, Brock and Stevenson present and accounted for; Chairman Carpenter presiding.

HIRTA Executive Director, Julia Castillo asked the Supervisors for \$32,785 for operating assistance and \$18,113 for capital replacement local match funds, to replace one bus, for a total request of \$50,898. Supervisor Stevenson said that the \$32,785 in operating assistance had been budgeted for but the \$18,113 to replace a bus had not. The Board asked that HIRTA alert the Supervisors at budget time of their needs instead of waiting until after the budget was certified.

Motion by Brock, seconded by Stevenson to approve \$32,785 in operating assistance for FY2016 for HIRTA Public Transit.

YEA: STEVENSON, BROCK, CARPENTER

Dave Lureman of Lureman/Steenhoek Insurance presented a commercial insurance program to the Board pointing out what he believed were deficiencies in the County's commercial insurance program. Lureman said that he could give the County proper coverage and may even be able to save the County some premium dollars.

Central lowa Community Services Director, Jody Eaton, asked the Board to approve the Proclamation to support STEPPING UP: A national initiative to reduce the number of people with mental illness in jails. Stepping Up draws on a diverse team of leaders from multiple agencies, collects and reviews prevalence numbers to assess individual's needs, examines treatment service capacities, develops a plan with measureable outcomes that draws on jail assessments and prevalence data, examines available treatment and service capacity, implements research based approaches and creates a process to track progress.

Motion by Brock, seconded by Stevenson to approve the Proclamation to Support the STEPPING UP INITIATIVE.


