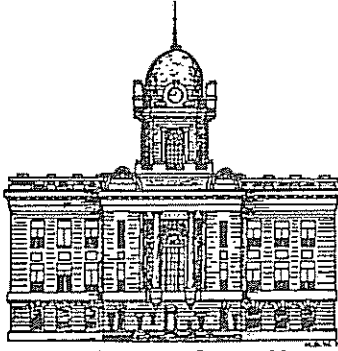

Location	Jasper County Jail Driveways and Parking Lots

Denco Highway Construction proposes to complete Hot Pour Random Crack Repairs on the listed Jasper County Jail HMA Pavement. Denco will seal the joints between the sidewalks and building and the joints between the sidewalks and HMA parking lots. All random cracks of the parking lots and driveways will also be sealed. Work will consist of routing the new random cracks, high-pressure air blowing them clean, and sealing with Iowa DOT approved Crafcro 231 Hot Pour Material.

Vehicle parking will need to be coordinated with Denco on the day of the project. As discussed, all vehicles will need to be moved once so all repairs can be completed in the same day.

Tuesday, August 25, 2015 the Jasper County Board of Supervisors met in regular session at 9:30 a.m. with Supervisors Carpenter, Brock & Stevenson present and accounted for; Chairman Carpenter presiding.

Motion by Stevenson, seconded by Brock to approve the request made by Kelley Martin to have a dunk tank on the courthouse lawn during Thunder Nights to raise money for the Autism Treatment Center of America Son-Rise Program.

YEA: BROCK, STEVENSON, CARPENTER

Larry Cleverley spoke to the Supervisors about his concerns with the Iowa DOT plans for the Hwy 65 intersection near Baxter. Cleverley said that he thought there were better and less expensive options to fix the intersection. Cleverley was also concerned about the amount of land he would lose in the project.

Pam Olson from the County Engineer's Office spoke to the Board concerning the LRTF Grant, the purchase of two aluminum boxes and a 28E Agreement between the County and the City of Newton to replace a road structure on N 4th Ave E. over the tributary to Elk Creek.

Motion by Brock seconded by Stevenson to adopt Resolution 15-40 approving the Living Roadway Trust Fund Grant Agreement in the amount of \$3,577.80 and to appoint Russell Stutt, Jasper County Engineer, as the Authorizing Official and Pam Olson, Assistant to the Engineer, as the Project Coordinator/Manager.
