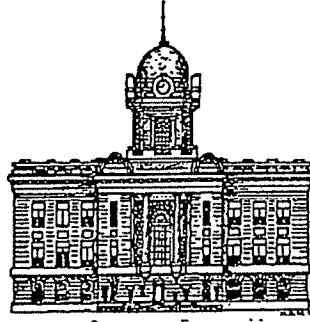

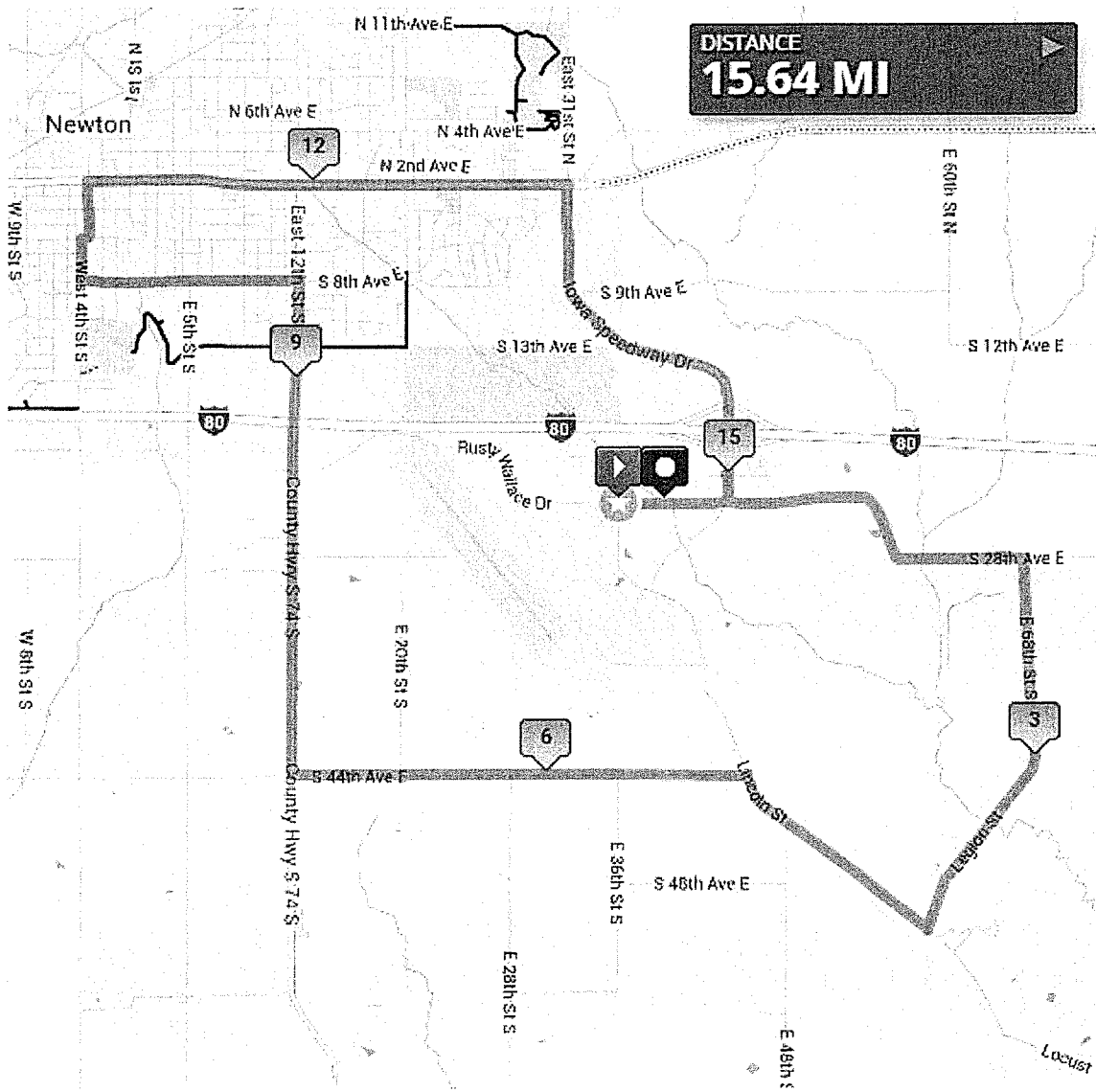

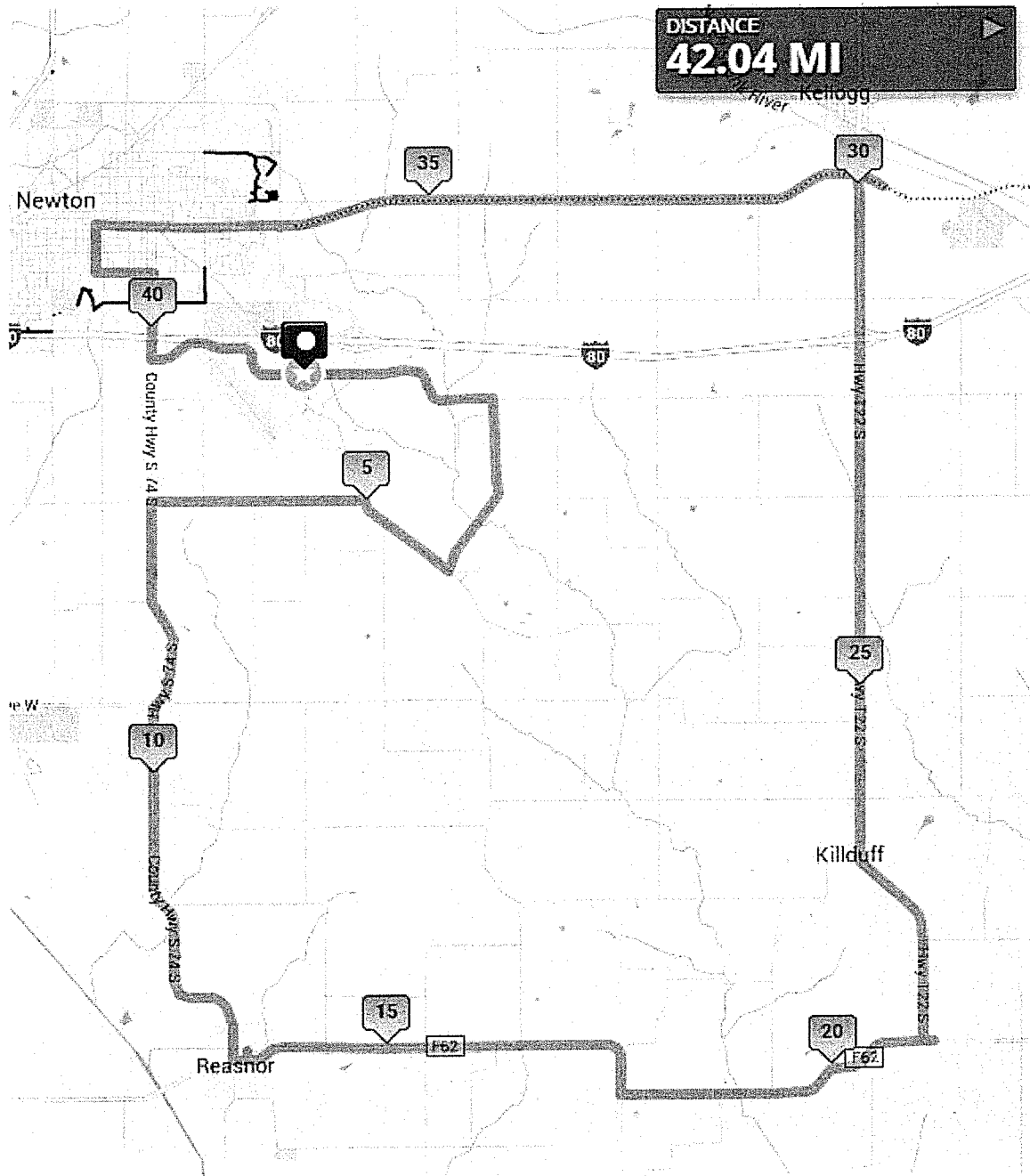

15.64 Mile Route



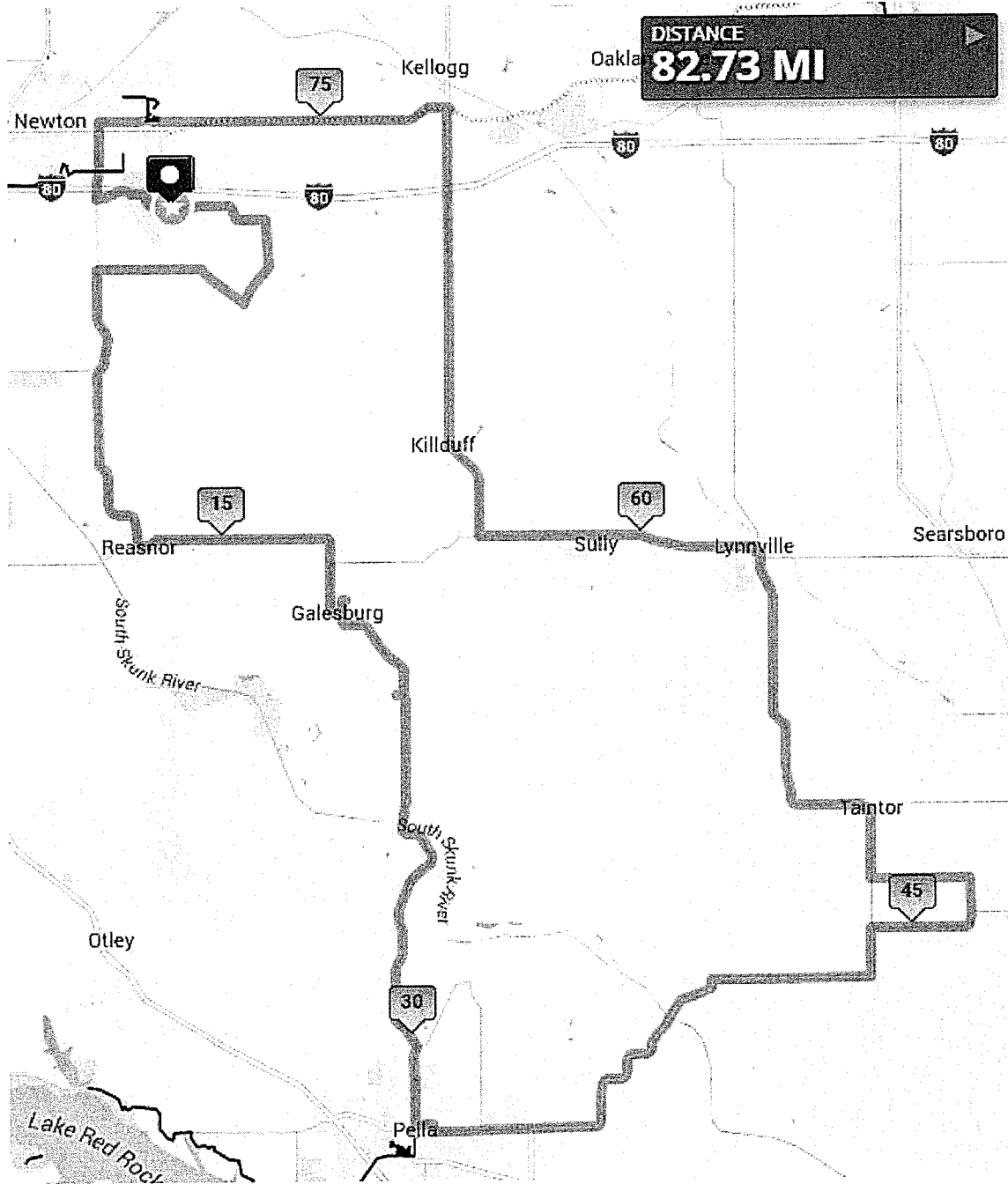
Map My Ride Route Info

**28E Agreement
Maintenance Subgrade Stabilization
and Surfacing**

This agreement made and entered into by and between the City of Colfax, Iowa hereinafter referred to as the City, and Jasper County, Iowa hereinafter referred to as the County.

In accord with Chapter 28E and other relevant sections of the Code of Iowa, the City and County enter into the following agreement regarding maintenance subgrade repair and surfacing of League Road from Highway F-48 proceeding north approximately 1000 feet.

1. Project cost is estimated to be \$80,000.00
2. The ownership of this project is forty percent County and sixty percent City.
3. The County will provide initial funding for the project.
4. The City will reimburse the County for sixty percent of actual project costs upon completion.
5. Survey, design, and inspection will be provided by the County.
