NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that any and all interests of Jasper County, Iowa in and to the following described real estate are hereby vacated and no longer shall be available for any public use for roadway or other public purposes other than utility purposes:

#### **DESCRIPTION TO VACATE PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY**

That portion of South 112th Avenue West beginning 1575 feet west of the West right-of-way line of West 78<sup>th</sup> Street South; thence westerly to the East right-of-way line of West 86<sup>th</sup> St South; all in Sections 20 and 29, Township 78 North, Range 20 West of the 5th P.M., Jasper County, Iowa. The Bridge, FHWA No. 195860, on this section of roadway will also be closed, vacated and become the property of the land owner.



- Performance. Services will be performed during normal working hours with any overtime or emergency labor billed separately, unless otherwise agreed to in writing.
