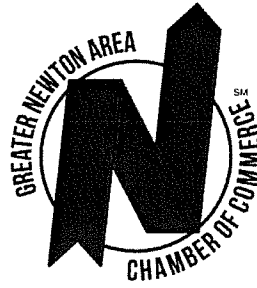

Tuesday, October 2, 2018 the Jasper County Board of Supervisors met in regular session at 9:30 a.m. Supervisors Brock, Carpenter and Cupples present and accounted for; Chairman Cupples presiding.

CICS Director Jody Eaton asked the Board to approve an MOU with Polk County for supplemental food services. The Program is provided to low income senior citizens aged 60 and older. Up to 200 Jasper County residents may obtain food packets in any month.

Motion by Carpenter and seconded by Brock to approve an MOU between Jasper County and Polk County Iowa for the Supplemental Food Program Services.
