Over the past couple of years, the department has purchased two (2) new tandem dumps, three (3) pickups, and a newer used hydraulic excavator. Given these purchases the department declared one hydraulic excavator, three (3) pickups, and two (2) dump trucks as surplus equipment. Also, our department identified an Eager Beaver trailer as surplus due to lack of use.

Sealed bids were requested for the sale this surplus equipment. An advertisement for this sale was published in the Newton Daily News, Hometown Press, and Jasper County Tribune. Also, the advertisement was posted on the Iowa County Engineers Association (ICEA) Service Bureau Q&A forum page, posted on secondary roads bulletin boards, and sent out through our counties communication system(s) by Jenn Cross. 




