

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RESOLUTION VACATING A PORTION OF JASPER COUNTY PUBLIC ROADWAY

BE IT RESOLVED that the Jasper County, Iowa roadway easements and other interests upon the real estate described in Attachment "A" are no longer necessary for any public purpose and ought now be vacated in the manner allowed by law,-- reserving however all of such area for general public utility usage and that easement access rights shall be granted to all existing utilities on said described road vacation to allow access to their current facilities, now and in the future, for maintenance, repair patrol, operation, and reconstruction of said facilities.

Dear Supervisors,

To maintain lane visibility and the safety of the paved roadways in the county, we requested and were granted approval on March 14, 2023, to purchase the pavement marking paint necessary to restripe every mile of paved road. Following up with the purchase of materials we prepared bid documents requesting proposals to provide the labor, equipment, and reflective beads to place this paint on the roads.

Four (4) bids were received, and they are as follows:

\$103,661.20	\$ 107,539.32	\$163,010.36	\$239,260.70	\$444,750.69

One technicality noted with some of the bids was lack of acknowledgment for Addendum 1. Addendum 1 reduced the rate of reflective beads required from 9 lbs. per gal (lowa DOT spec) to 6 lbs. per gal. The 6 lbs. per gallon rate is past practice in the county and achieves equivalent results as the higher rate at less cost. The second low bidder, Quality Striping, Inc., claims not to have received this addendum, and the apparent low bidder, KAM Line Highway Marking, bid it at the lower rate without acknowledging receipt of the addendum. Given that the cost savings realized by the lower rate would not put the second low bidder at or below the apparent low bidder we recommend waiving this technicality.

After consideration of the bid submitted by KAM Line Highway Marking, and the reasonable costs the bid represents, the Jasper County Highway Department recommends approving the proposal from KAM Line Highway Markings for painted pavement marking work at a total cost of \$107,539.32.

Dear Supervisors,

Cleaning and filling pavement cracks prevents water from migrating into the pavement surface or the base of the pavement. Water that migrates into the pavement surface freezes during the winter causing potholes, surface delamination, and other deterioration leading to full or partial depth patching. Also, water that migrates into the base causes it to lose compaction, particularly after undergoing freeze thaw cycle(s), and the resulting settlement causes failure of the entire pavement structure. Given the need for cleaning and filling pavement cracks observed in the northwest quadrant of the county, bid documents were prepared to clean and fill cracks on highways F-24, S-52, S-62, and F-17.

Two (2) bids were received, and they are as follows:
