

# MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN JASPER COUNTY, IOWA, DANIEL D RUNNER, AND DAVID A RUNNER CONCERNING INSTALLATION AND FUTURE MAINTENCE OF PRIVATE UTILITIES CROSSING PUBLIC ROAD EASEMENTS

- 1. <u>PARTIES.</u> This Memorandum of Understanding ("MOU") is between Jasper County, Iowa, ("Jasper County"), Daniel D Runner (Daniel Runner), and David A Runner ("David Runner").
- 2. <u>PURPOSE</u>. The purpose of this Memorandum of Understanding is to address private utility crossings, internal to the properties owned by Daniel D Runner, David A Runner, and/or its current or future tenants, within the respective right-of-way of Jasper County with respect to the roadways known as N 107<sup>th</sup> Ave E and E 116<sup>th</sup> St N in Jasper County (collectively, the "ROW"), and located between the real estate owned by Daniel Runner ("Property A") known as 10787 E 116<sup>th</sup> St N Gilman, IA 50106, and legally described as

Parcel A in the Southeast Quarter (SE ¼) of the Southeast Quarter (SE ¼) Section Six (6), Township Eighty-one (81) North, Range Seventeen (17) West of the 5th P.M. in Jasper County, Iowa, as appears in plat recorded in Book 1156 Page 407 in the office of the Recorder of Jasper County, Iowa

and the real estate owned by David A Runner ("Property B") known as 11473 N 107<sup>th</sup> Ave E Gilman, IA 50106, and legally described as:

A tract of land, described as the North 670.35 feet of the East 1300.00 feet of the Northeast Quarter (NE ¼) of the Northeast Quarter (NE ¼) of Section 7, Township 81 North, Range 17 West of the 5<sup>th</sup> P.M., Jasper County, Iowa, as recorded in the deed found in Book 939 Page 280 in the office of the Recorder of Jasper County, Iowa.

and the real estate owned by David A Runner ("Property C"), and legally described as:

A tract of land, described as the Northwest (NW ¼) of the Northwest (NW ¼) of Section 8, Township 81 North, Range 17 West of the 5<sup>th</sup> P.M., Jasper County, Iowa

3. <u>TERM OF MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING</u>. This Memorandum of Understanding is effective upon the date of its signing, and it shall be perpetual unless otherwise noted hereafter.

#### 4. JASPER COUNTY DUTIES AND OBLIGATIONS.

Upon mutual acceptance of this agreement, Jasper County shall allow the installation, use, operation, maintenance, repair and/or replacement of a gravity (non-pressurized) storm sewer pipeline (Storm Sewer) across the ROW but within the ROW Corridors (as defined below) by Daniel Runner and David Runner. Jasper County will remain responsible for maintenance and improvement of N 107<sup>th</sup> Ave E and E 116<sup>th</sup> St N, including the ROW Corridors. Before performing maintenance and improvement work on N 107<sup>th</sup> Ave E or E 116<sup>th</sup> St N within the ROW Corridors that involves excavation, Jasper County shall call Iowa One Call (811) and use reasonable efforts to avoid damage to Storm Sewer placed within the ROW Corridors by Daniel Runner and David Runner.

5. <u>DANIEL AND DAVID RUNNER DUTIES AND OBLIGATIONS.</u> Upon the mutual acceptance of this agreement, and subject to its terms, Daniel Runner and David Runner shall be entitled to install, operate, maintain, repair and/or replace Storm Sewer within a 20 foot wide corridor across the ROW of N 107<sup>th</sup> Ave E and E 116<sup>th</sup> St N (the "ROW Corridors"), such ROW Corridors to consist of the following:

#### Corridor 1

A corridor starting 100 feet south of the southeast corner of the existing right-of-way at the intersection of N 107<sup>th</sup> Ave E and E 116<sup>th</sup> St N and on the east right-of-way line of E 116<sup>th</sup> St N, hereby known as the point of beginning (POB); thence south 20 feet from POB along the east right-of-way line of E 116<sup>th</sup> St N; thence west to the west right-of-way line at a bearing perpendicular to said right-of-way line, thence north 20 along the west right-of-way line, thence east back to the POB.

#### Corridor 2

A corridor starting at the northwest corner of the existing right-of-way at the intersection of N 107<sup>th</sup> Ave E and E 116<sup>th</sup> St N, hereby known as the point of beginning (POB); thence south from POB to the southwest corner of the existing right-of-way at the intersection of N 107<sup>th</sup> Ave E and E 116<sup>th</sup> St N; thence west 20 feet along existing south right-of-way line of N 107<sup>th</sup> Ave E, thence north to north right-of-way line of N 107<sup>th</sup> Ave E at a bearing perpendicular to said right-of-way line; thence east back to the POB.

A ROW Corridors Map is attached as Exhibit A to this MOU.

An executed copy of this MOU shall be recorded by Daniel Runner with the Jasper County, Iowa Recorder. Daniel Runner shall be responsible for reporting the presence of this Storm Sewer to Iowa One Call (811) and to provide a system to trace and/or locate Storm Sewer within the ROW corridors. Jasper County shall be held harmless from

damages to the Storm Sewer by other utilities located in the right-of-way if said utilities should need to be maintained, modified, or replaced within the ROW Corridors.

Daniel Runner shall be responsible at his expense for repairing the ROW Corridors after installation of utilities including the pipeline, and for any damage caused by such installation, or the use or operation of such utilities, and shall also be responsible at its expense for making any repairs to the ROW Corridors after any subsequent maintenance, repair or replacement of utilities it installs within the ROW Corridors, and said utilities shall be limited to Storm Sewer. Daniel Runner (or its successors and assigns) shall maintain responsibility for the use, operation, maintenance, repair and/or replacement of the Storm Sewer within the ROW Corridors.

Daniel Runner agrees to indemnify and hold harmless Jasper County for any claims asserted by any third party for personal injury, death or property damage to the extent caused by any negligent acts or omissions of Daniel Runner or any of its agents, with respect to the installation, operation, maintenance, repair and/or replacement of Storm Sewer by Daniel Runner within the ROW Corridors. Provided Jasper County comply with its obligations under the last sentence of Section 4 above, Daniel Runner shall be responsible at its expense for repairing the Storm Sewer placed by Daniel Runner within the ROW Corridors with respect to damages caused by roadwork performed by Jasper County on either N 107<sup>th</sup> Ave E or E 116<sup>th</sup> St N.


- 6. REMEDIES OF THE PARTIES. Jasper County, Daniel Runner, and David Runner are entitled to utilize any and all remedies or actions at law or in equity available to them, and the prevailing parties shall be entitled to obtain a judgment for costs and reasonable attorney fees. However, the parties agree that any legal disputes would be litigated in Jasper County, Iowa.
- 7. MODIFICATION OF MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING. This Memorandum of Understanding may be modified only by written agreement between the parties. No party has the right to revoke or modify any provision of this agreement, including the term, without the prior written consent of the other parties hereto. Nothing in this Memorandum of Understanding shall prevent Daniel Runner from leasing Property A or David Runner from leasing Properties B and C to a tenant or tenants, including the right to use operate, maintain, repair and/or replace Storm Sewer placed in the ROW Corridors by Daniel Runner.
- 8. MISCELLANEOUS. This Memorandum of Understanding (a) is binding upon and shall inure to the benefit of the parties and their respective successors and assigns, and (b) may be executed in separate counterparts each of which will be an original and all of which taken together will constitute one and the same agreement. The rights granted by Jasper County under this Memorandum of Understandings shall run with the land comprising Property A, Property B, and Property C.

The parties are causing this Memorandum of Understanding to be become binding and effective as of the date when all parties have signed this Memorandum of Understanding.
